



## Child Protection

Glazy Days instructors accept that all children and young people have the following basic rights:

- to be valued as a person
- to be treated with dignity and respect
- to be cared for as a young person
- to be kept safe

Glazy Days instructors will provide a workshop or party session in which each young person feels safe and cared for, is valued, and is treated with dignity and respect. Glazy Days instructors will provide a duty of care to protect each young person from abuse

### **GLAZY DAYS CHILD PROTECTION POLICY STATEMENT**

Glazy Days will:

Accept that all young people regardless of age, gender, ability, race, creed, nationality, ethnicity, sexual orientation and/or social/economic status have a right to be protected from abuse.

Accept the moral and legal responsibility to provide a duty of care for young people and implement procedures to safeguard their well-being and protect them from abuse.

Respect and promote the rights, wishes and feelings of young people.

Recruit, train and supervise its employees, volunteers, teachers and accredited organisations to adopt the best practice to safeguard and protect young people from abuse, and themselves against false allegations.

Require employees, volunteers, teachers and accredited organisations to adopt and abide by this Child Protection Policy.

Respond to any concerns and/or allegations appropriately and swiftly, and implement the appropriate disciplinary and appeals procedures.

Accepts its duty to implement a Child Protection Policy that protects and upholds the safe practice of arts and crafts with children, as part of its overall aim to provide good,

safe, suitably qualified or experienced instructors.

Accept that it is the responsibility of the statutory child protection experts to determine whether or not abuse has taken place, but it is everyone's responsibility to report any concerns.

Accept the right of all children and young people to practice ceramic painting in an enjoyable and safe environment.
